Class 2 NOVICE HORSE, any type - open to hunters, cobs, riding horses, hacks, coloureds etc

Class 3 HUNTERS, all weights, and Small Hunters
★ Special rosette for Ladies Hunter ridden Side Saddle

Class 4 COBS Lightweight, Heavyweight and Maxi cobs

Class 5 COLOURED HORSES AND PONIES any type

★ Special rosette to highest conformation mark

Class 10 M AND M LARGE BREEDS
★ Special rosette to highest conformation mark

Please respect all government guidelines in place at the time of the show, as we are trying to help you get your horses and ponies out to a show in a very safe environment.

General information

- As with the earlier shows, class sizes will be strictly limited, so you will need to get your entry in.
- All classes will run in my outdoor international size arena with each class divided into small groups, one group at a time in the arena to enable you to maintain safe distancing
- To maintain safety at all times Mark Sheets will be used so there is no close contact with the judge at any time before, during or after the class.
- In the event of a tie then the horse/pony with the highest conformation mark will be the winner. In the event of a further tie, the judge's decision will be final.

How to enter

- You enter online via an entry form on www.topcobs.com and will be allocated a back number (please provide your own neatly written card).
- Entries close 7 days in advance of each show.
- Entry fees are £12 per class, £3 First Aid/Admin per rider/handler and £2 PayPal transaction fee
- No late/on the day entries under any circumstances and all entries must be paid at the time of entry.
- Once entries have closed you will be emailed time slot(s) for your class(es).

Here's how it going to run

- The first group of horses/ponies will enter the ring at the same time.
- Ridden Classes - the standard showing class format will be used starting with a go round. On this showground, a correctly fitting riding hat with chin strap is compulsory.
- Judges will NOT ride you will need to do an individual show.
- Your ridden show should show walk away from the judge trot, change of diagonal, and canter with a change of rein and NO galloping as we all must stay safe.
- In hand classes - the usual format, walk away and trot only. Irrespective of any society guidelines, on this showground a correctly fitting riding hat is compulsory.
- All exhibits will be stripped for conformation.
- Once the first group has finished Mark Sheets will be completed by the judge and the process will be repeated until the class has finished.
- Each group will leave the ring and return to lorries and implement the stay safe social distancing as recommended at the time of the show.

Results

- The results will be announced once each class has been completed.
- Rosettes will be presented if able to maintain social distancing measures in place at the time. Otherwise or if preferred, rosettes will be mailed out to you after the show.
- Results will also be published after the show on www.topcobs.com and on my FB page

Conditions of Entry

- There will be a first aider on hand.
- Anyone competing in more than one class must return to their lorry and observe all government guidelines. Anyone failing to do this will be asked to leave and no refund will be given.
- To maintain safety guidelines all competitors are asked to leave the showground once their class(es) have finished unless they are involved in as Championship.
- We hope to arrange refreshments, subject to guidelines in place at the time, but there will be no toilet facilities so be sure to make your own arrangements.
- Parking, we will endeavour to help you park there is plenty of space, so please allow plenty between each vehicle and do not tie horses or ponies to your transport.
- A one-way entry and exit system will be in place, please follow the signs.
- Dogs must stay in your lorry.
- Only bring horses and ponies that you have entered.
- All other rules pertaining to shows at Durfold Farm must be observed and are published on my website
- We may amend the rules to suit any changes in government policy.
